Dual N & P-Channel PowerTrench® MOSFET

General Description

These dual N and P-Channel enhancement mode power field effect transistors are produced using MOS-TECH Semiconductor's advanced PowerTrench process that has been especially tailored to minimize on-state resistance and yet maintain superior switching performance.

These devices are well suited for low voltage and battery powered applications where low in-line power loss and fast switching are required.






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Simplified Schematic






Figure 1:Switching Test Circuit




Figure 3 Power Dissipation




Figure 5 Output Characteristics




Figure 2:Switching Waveforms




Figure 4 Drain Current






Figure 6 Drain-Source On-Resistance



Figure 9 Rdson vs Vgs





Figure 11 Gate Charge



T_J-Junction Temperature(°C)




Figure 10 Capacitance vs Vds





Figure 12 Source- Drain Diode Forward

Figure 13 Safe Operation Area




Figure 14 Normalized Maximum Transient Thermal Impedance




Figure 1:Switching Test Circuit




Figure 3 Power Dissipation




Figure 5 Output Characteristics




Figure 2:Switching Waveforms




Figure 4 Drain Current





Figure 6 Drain-Source On-Resistance

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


Figure 13 Safe Operation Area







Figure 14 Normalized Maximum Transient Thermal Impedance


