General Description

These dual N and P-Channel enhancement mode power field effect transistors are produced using MOS-TECH Semiconductor's advanced PowerTrench process that has been especially tailored to minimize on-state resistance and yet maintain superior switching performance.

These devices are well suited for low voltage and battery powered applications where low in-line power loss and fast switching are required.



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
Simplified Schematic




Figure 1. On-Region Characteristics.




Figure 3. On-Resistance Variation with Temperature.




Figure 5. Transfer Characteristics.




Figure 2. On-Resistance Variation with Drain Current and Gate Voltage.




Figure 4. On-Resistance Variation with Gate-to-Source Voltage.




Figure 6. Body Diode Forward Voltage Variation with Source Current and Temperature.




Figure 7. Gate Charge Characteristics.




Figure 9. Maximum Safe Operating Area.




Figure 8. Capacitance Characteristics.




Figure 10. Single Pulse Maximum Power Dissipation.




Figure 11. On-Region Characteristics.




Figure 13. On-Resistance Variation with Temperature.




Figure 15. Transfer Characteristics.




Figure 12. On-Resistance Variation with Drain Current and Gate Voltage.




Figure 14. On-Resistance Variation with Gate-to-Source Voltage.





Figure 16. Body Diode Forward Voltage Variation with Source Current and Temperature.




Figure 17. Gate Charge Characteristics.




Figure 18. Capacitance Characteristics.




Figure 19. Maximum Safe Operating Area.







Figure 21. Transient Thermal Response Curve.
